We have recently had requests from parents for permission to take their child out of school for holidays.

As from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2013, the change to the law does not give any entitlement to parents to take any child of compulsory school age (five years old) on holiday during term time. Any application for leave must be in exceptional circumstances and the Head Teacher must be satisfied that the circumstances warrant the granting of the leave. Parents can be fined by the Local Authority for taking their children on holiday during term time without consent from the school.
